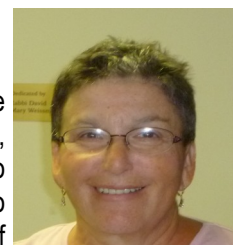

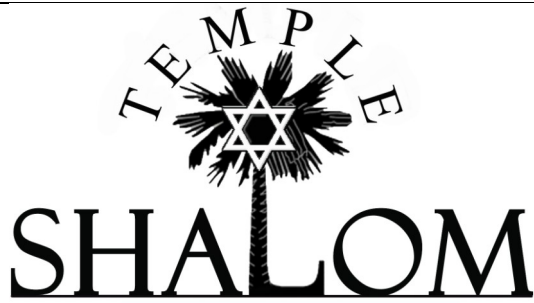
### SHABBAT SERVICES
