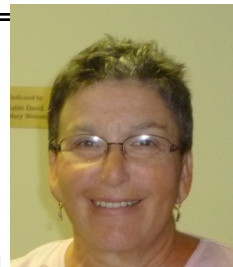

### **A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENTS FINALLY! TEMPLE SHALOM IS OPENING AGAIN!**



We have great news from the Board of Directors Meeting held on Sunday, April 18, 2021. We plan to open our synagogue for our annual Congregational Meeting on Thursday, June 10, 2021 at 3:00 PM. We will be voting for our new slate of officers

and directors as well as making several dedications for new plaques to be hung in the Temple. Your attendance at this meeting is important for the future of Temple Shalom!

More great news! The Board voted to enter into contract negotiations with Rabbi Gordon Fuller to be our part-time Rabbi. He will join us at the congregational meeting. Please plan to join with our congregation family for this momentous occasion.

Shabbat evening services will continue on Facebook for the time being. We hope our virtual visitors will continue to support us and become members of Temple Shalom. We are hoping that Rabbi Weissman will continue to hold Zoom services on Shabbat morning. Rabbi Fuller will come to us for long weekends (dates to be announced) throughout the year, and he will be with us the entire High Holiday period.

To keep all of us as safe and secure as possible, **APPROPRIATE MASKS COVERING YOUR NOSE AND MOUTH MUST BE WORN IN THE TEMPLE AT ALL TIMES UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.** Chairs are set in place so we are socially distant based on CDC guidelines. There will be extra masks on hand and hand sanitizing stations for your safety. There will be **NO FOOD** for the time being. Feel free to bring your own water since we will not have any in the Temple. Service leaders will stand behind plexiglass so they will sing and chant and read as always. Please be cautious about singing in the audience.

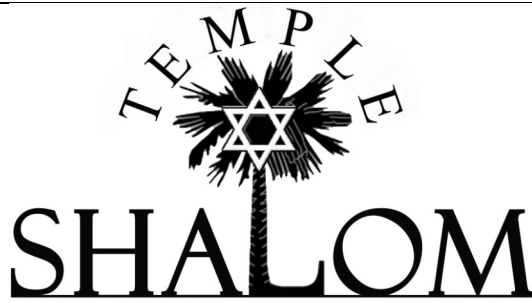
